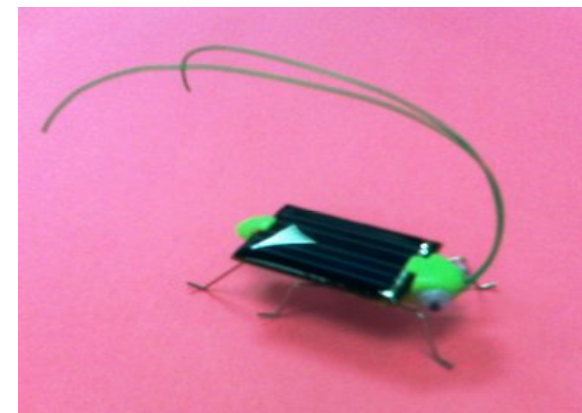

The Solar Print Kit provides for each student to design and make their own stationery powered from the sun. The student may use the enclosed stencils or find items in nature such as leaves, acorns, sticks, flower petals, and the like. The paper undergoes a chemical change when exposed to sunlight. Within minutes, the custom solar prints are available for note cards or for framing. Children will learn the sun's light does have utilization beyond providing light and heat. Sharpen your art and marketing skills.

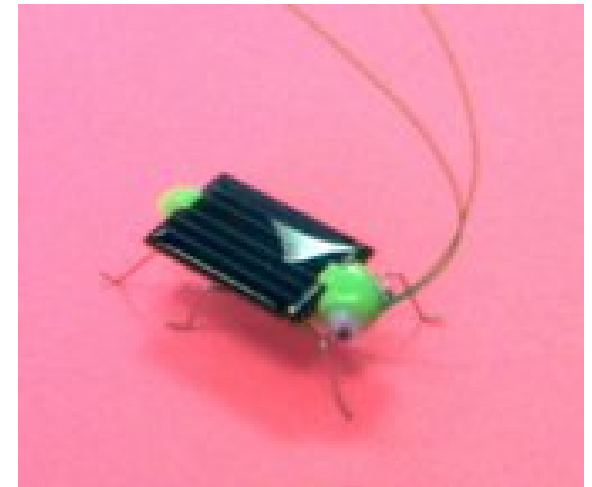
